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TRAFFIC ADVISORY FOR IMMEDIATE RELEASE
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Route 7 (Leesburg Pike) East Utility Relocation Lane Shift

Utility relocation for the Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project will cause a lane shift of eastbound Leesburg Pike (Route 7) starting on or about March 6 or 9, weather permitting. This lane shift affects eastbound lanes of Leesburg Pike near Pike 7 Plaza to accommodate utility work in the right lane.

Traffic will shift to the left and an additional lane will be created in the existing median to maintain three travel lanes. The map below illustrates the location and the new traffic pattern, which will remain in place for approximately nine months.

Dulles Corridor Metrorail Project will continue to keep the public informed of changing traffic patterns as construction moves forward. Use caution when entering work areas and pay attention to traffic directional signs.

In addition, closures will continue in several sections of the service roads adjacent to east and westbound Route 7 between Chain Bridge Road (Route 123) and the Dulles Toll Road. Motorists should stay alert and be prepared to alter their travel on these service roads. Use caution when entering work areas and pay attention to traffic directional signs. Access to all businesses will be maintained throughout the work periods.
